IMPORTANT CIRCULAR TO OUR VALUED CUSTOMERS

WEATHER DELAY AFFECTING FORUM PACIFIC

We wish to advise that *Forum Pacific*, currently on voyage 13, was held up for an extended period in port in Rarotonga, due to the prevailing wind and sea conditions. These were part of a weather system which has affected other ships in the region: in the case of *Forum Pacific* they prevented her from sailing from Avatiu for four days after cargo work had been completed. We very much regret the delays and resultant inconvenience to our valued shippers and importers, but for obvious safety reasons have to be guided by our ship's master and by the local authorities at the port.

Unfortunately there will be flow on effects for her forward schedule, and revised voyage dates are now therefore as follows:
